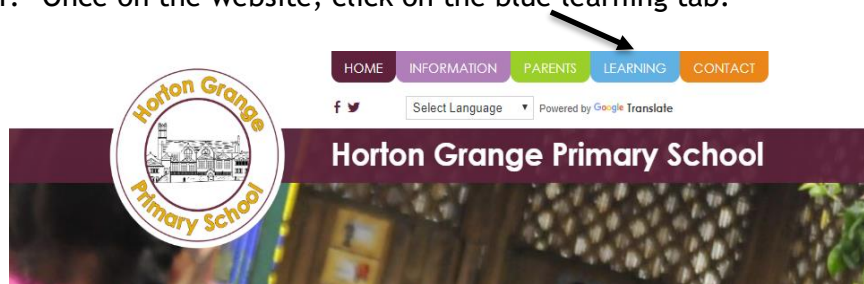
Learning from Home

As always, please ensure that your child supervised by a responsible adult whilst accessing the internet at home. This includes when children are playing on iPads, phones and game consoles. If possible, set up parental permissions so that children can only visit websites which are safe for them to access. All of the websites that we have recommended as a school are safe for children to access.

Please note age restrictions for different apps that older siblings may have access to. Some of these are not appropriate for primary school aged children to access.
