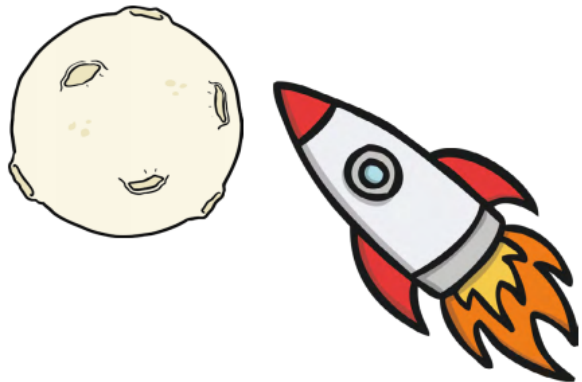

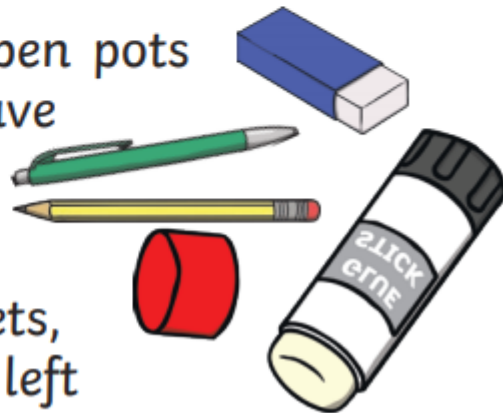
Clean the Classroom
