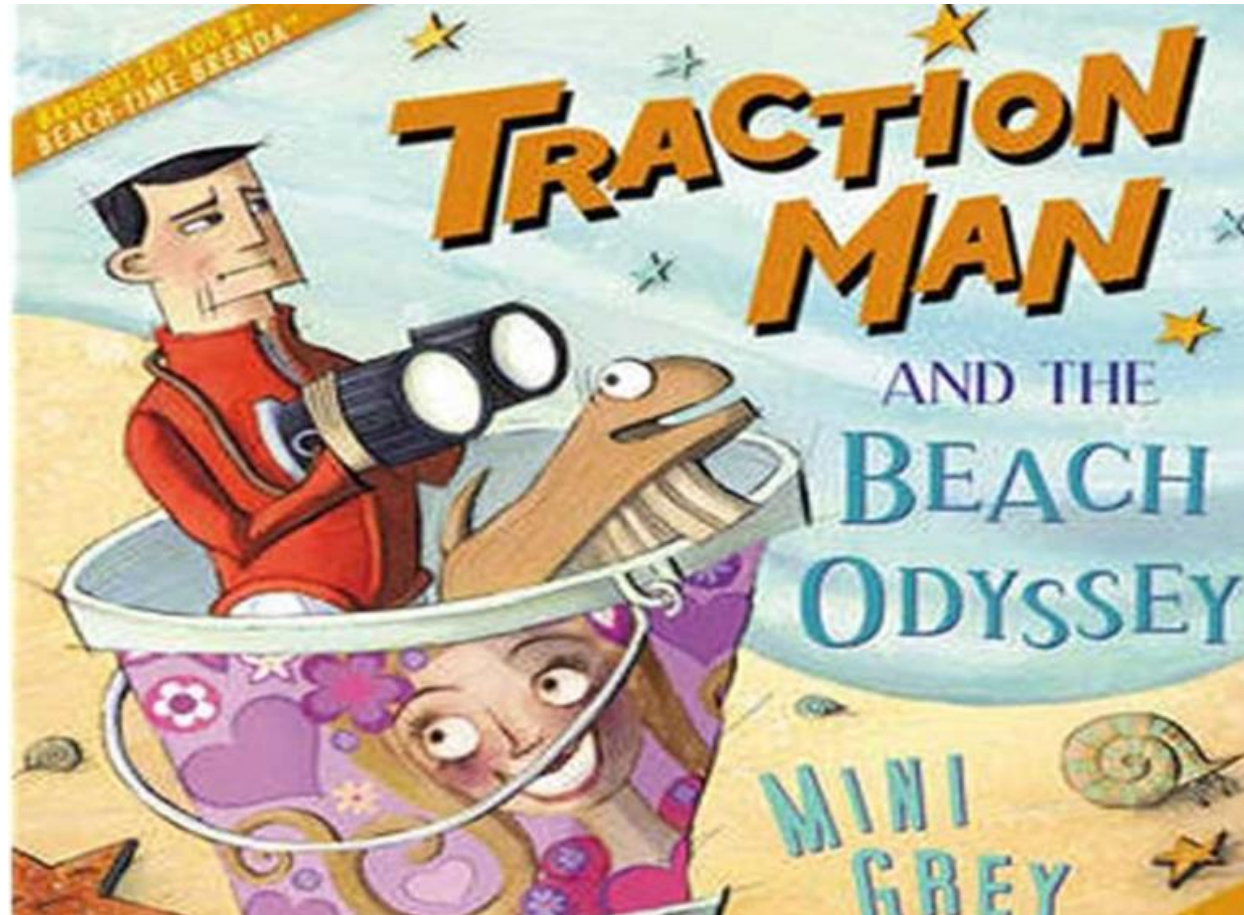

# Writing an adventure story.

- Remember what we need to include in an adventure story:
  - **A Title** - An exciting name for your story so your readers will want to find out more.
  - **A beginning** - Set the scene. Where does the story take place? This called the setting.
  - **A build -up** - The beginning of your story , Who is there? (Who are your characters?)
    - Why are they there? What are they doing?
  - **A dilemma (or problem)** - Oh no! Something has happened!!!! What can it be?
    - (TIP - there might be more than one.)
  - **A resolution** - How does the dilemma get resolved? (Phew , it got sorted out!)
  - **The ending** - How did your story end? Was it a party? A picnic? A boat ride home?

# The beginning of your story

# The middle of your story

- Today you will be writing the middle of the story.
- This is the part where you will explain the problem and the dilemma.
- What is a problem?
- What is the problem going to be in your story?
- Can you add even more ideas to your problem when you write it down.

Before you start to write read back the work you did yesterday.

# The ending of your story.

- Today you will be writing the end of your story.
- This is the part where you will explain how the problem got sorted out (the resolution) and the happy ending.
- How did the problem get solved? Which characters were involved?
- Think about your story mountain and what you wrote for the ending.



# Editing your work

- Today you need to read back your work and see if you need to make any improvements.
- Look at your spellings carefully.
- Have you included adjectives?
- Have you included conjunctions (and, so, but , if, because)?
- Add these details to the story by changing your writing.

- Today you need to use your best writing to copy out your story adding in all of your changes.
