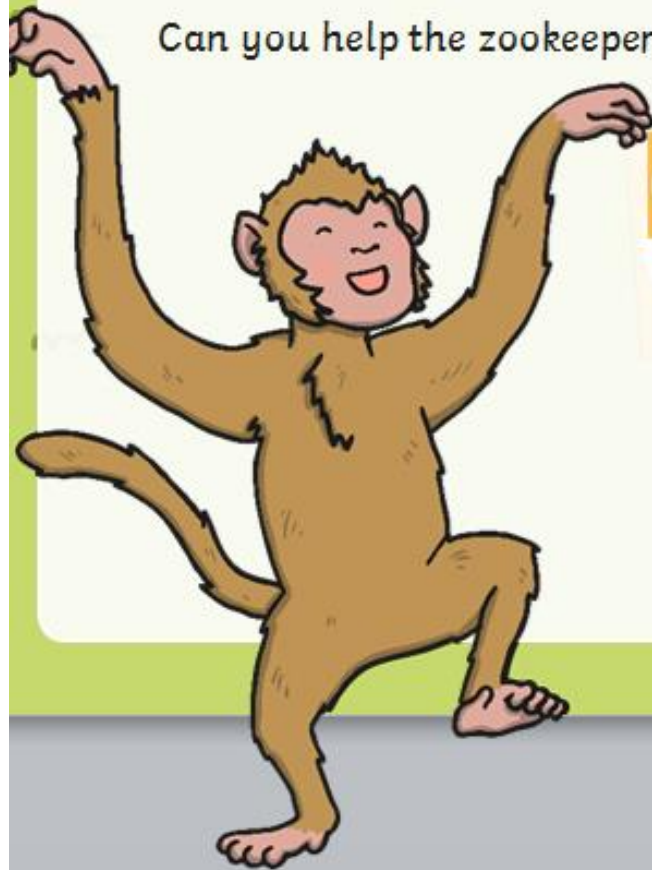
Can you count to 5?

Can you help the zookeeper work out what one more will be?

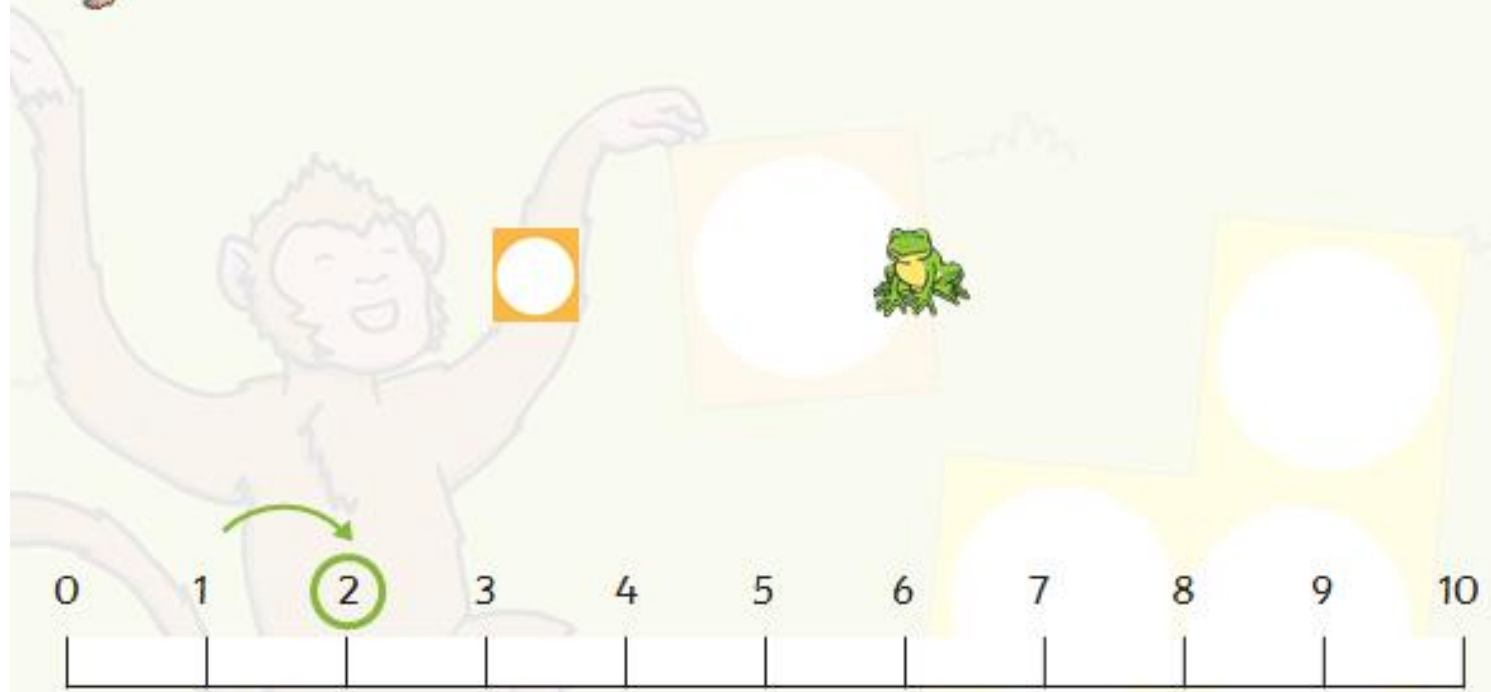

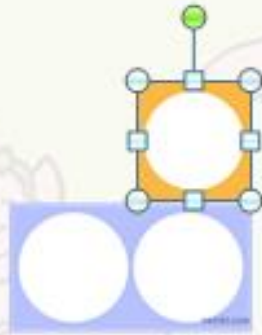

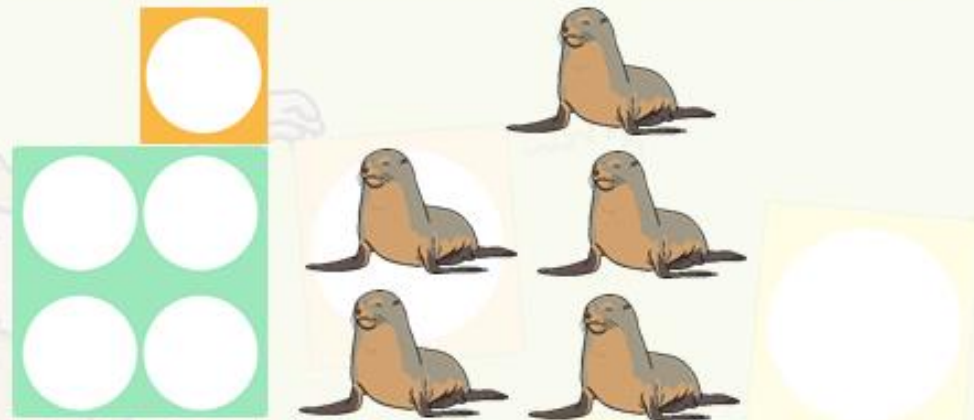
A number line from 0 to 10 is shown at the bottom. The number 5 is circled in green, and a green arrow points from the number 4 to the number 5.
