Day 1 - Reading

Sing this rhyme together. Encourage your child to repeat after you.

Pat-a-cake, pat-a-cake, baker's man.

Bake me a cake as fast as you can.

Pat it...

And roll it...

And mark it with 'B'.

Then put it in the oven for baby and me.

Day 2 Phonics

Play a listening game together called 'Adjust the Volume'.

If you have any instruments at home you can use them for this game if not try putting a small amount of rice or pasta in a Tupperware tub to make a shaker.

Play your instrument very quietly then pass it to your child and ask them to make a sound that is either louder or quieter.

You can repeat this lots of times using different volumes.

Day 3 Communicating

Make some playdough together.

- 3 cups of plain flour
- 3 cups of water with added food colouring of your choice
- 1 ½ cups of salt
- 6 tablespoons of cooking oil
- 6 teaspoons of cream of tartar

Put all of the ingredients into a pan over a low heat, and continue to stir until it all comes together. Take out of the pan, let cool and enjoy! If kept in a tupperware tub the playdough should last a while.

Using playdough is really good for your child's physical skills and encourages communication and imagination. You could even make the cakes from the nursery rhyme.

Day 4 - Reading
